

FOID card policy

Our Policy regarding FOID Cards

The Illinois Department of Human Services, IDHS, requires mental health professionals to report information about any client (or participating in therapy) who is assessed as presenting a clear and present danger to themselves, any other person or the community in general. This information must be forward to IDHS (mental health providers are mandated reporters and are immunized for making a good faith report). These reports are made to IDHS which processes these reports and forwards them to the State Police who will make a determination regarding whether the reported person's Firearm's ID (FOID card) should be revoked or an application is approved.
