FOID Card Policy

The Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) requires mental health professionals to report information about any client, or individual participating in therapy, who is assessed as presenting a clear and present danger to themselves, any other person, or the community in general. This information must be forwarded to IDHS as mental health providers are mandated reporters and are immunized for making a good faith report. These reports are made to IDHS to be processed then forwarded to the State Police. The State Police will then make a determination regarding whether the reported individual's Firearm's ID (FOID card) should be revoked or an application is approved.
